Student Government	UC 236A	280-6229	To promote cooperation among University of New Orleans students, faculty and administration, The SG also provides funding for student activities, for example travel to conferences, and funding for events. The SG also has a legal assistance service for students.
Student Health Services	UC 238	280-6387	Student Health Services offers limited health care to the UNO community. Services include, immunizations, basic first aid, treatment of minor illness, STD testing, birth control, physical exams, gynecological exam, chronic disease maintenance. Programs to stop smoking, stress management, and nutrition are also offered.

Registrar's Office	LIB (PEC) *1 ST Floor	280-3246	This office handles records for the university. It also is the place where you apply to be accepted to the university. This is also the office that takes care of transcripts and transfer credits.
Bursar's Office	AD 1006	280-6489	This office handles the money. You can pay any fees (tuition, transcript fees, parking tickets, etc.) here, and you get reimbursement, or payroll checks here. Visit the Bursar's Welcome Letter , for detail information.
Student Financial Aid	AD 1005	280-6603	Gives students advice and assistance with student loans, grants, and scholarships. Handles paperwork and processes student financial aid.
