- Look up the UNO department, level, and course number of any classes you think may have a UNO equivalent. Your UNO academic advisor and/or study abroad staff may be helpful in finding some of this information.
- Any direct UNO equivalency you list must be approved in writing by memo or e-mail thread by the UNO department offering the equivalent course. Attach any approvals to this form.
- For non-equivalencies (NE), list the level (2000, 3000) and "NE" (i.e., HIST 2000 NE). Departmental approval is not required for non-equivalencies.
- If you are not sure of the equivalency, show any available material to your advisor to determine the appropriate department and level. If there is no equivalent, list it as NE.
- Have your advisor and study abroad program director sign at the end of the form.
- Submit this form to the study abroad program director's office at least 4 weeks prior to your departure.
- If your classes change on-site (which they often do), send any amendments to your academic advisor for approval, and then to the respective UNO study abroad program office. Use the Change Form available online at <u>http://new.uno.edu/studyabroad/isep/outgoing-students/BeforeYouLeave</u>
- Regardless of what approvals you receive ahead of time, ALWAYS keep any relevant information about courses you take abroad (syllabi, completed assignments, etc.).
- NOTE: Credits listed are to establish that the student is enrolled full time, but they are not guaranteed to transfer as stated by the student.
