Eligibility

A UNO undergraduate who is within twelve hours of completing a baccalaureate degree at UNO may be approved to take up to nine hours total of graduate courses with permission of the department. Students must have a 3.2 cumulative GPA to qualify. Post-baccalaureate students and students on Letters of Good Standing from other institutions are not eligible.

Policy

Students enrolling under this policy must meet undergraduate and graduate academic performance requirements for the respective courses. For graduate courses the grade of A indicates superior performance and the grade of B indicates satisfactory performance. Grades of C or below are considered less than satisfactory. A cumulative grade-point average of 3.0 is considered by the Graduate School to be a minimum standard of academic performance. The student must also file an Adjustment/Substitution and Waiver Form in the Registrar's office to identify how the courses will apply to the degree.

Enrollment

After the attached form has been signed and delivered to the Graduate School, the graduate courses will be entered into the student's record separately from the undergraduate courses. Tuition will be assessed at the undergraduate rate for all courses. **Any aid funded by the university will be awarded. Stipulations may apply to federal and state aid (excluding TOPS) for graduate courses. Scholarships will not be extended beyond the original time limit.**

Due Date

In order for your courses to be added to your schedule correctly you must submit the completed form with requisite signatures to the Graduate School prior to the last day to add a course for the semester in question. Late schedule adjustments via appeal will not be permitted.
