
## Manually Importing a Moodle Course File into Canvas

- 1. Log in to Moodle and open the course you would like to import into Canvas.
- **2.** In the menu bar at the top of your course page, select the Course Management button (gear icon Course Management button looks like 3 gears). The Course Management panel will open.



**3.** On the Course Management panel, under Course Settings, select Backup.



4. Scroll to the bottom of the page. Select Jump to final step. Your backup will start.




5. When the backup is complete, you will see a confirmation message: "The backup file was successfully created." Click Continue.

6. In the Course backup area, find your file. It will end with .mbz as the file type. Click Download.




- 7. Keep track of where on your computer your .mbz file is downloaded.

- 9. Click the Import Existing Content button on the right side of your Canvas course homepage.

- 12. Next to Content, choose All content.
