Approval of the minutes from the 5/4/23 meeting were postponed.

Darrell Kruger provided an update from the Provost's Office and introduction of the Interim President Jeanine O'Rourke. It should be approved at the next board meeting. The Canvas migration has gone well and an update will be provided later in the meeting. He formally introduced Interim President Jeanine O.Rourke.

Interim President Jeanine O'Rourke introduced herself and went over some of her history with UNO. She encouraged participation in the Presidential search and provided clarification about the transition process.

Beth Blankenship provided an update on the Canvas rollout. The transition to Canvas was able to happen on time. Trainings were offered to faculty during the summer on campus and virtually. She discussed some challenges that occurred with the migration. Questions and discussion followed. She provided information in a PowerPoint presentation, which is attached to these minutes.

Chris Broadhurst gave an updated on the presidential search. He gathered feedback from campus over the summer and provided a summary of that to the search committee. Five finalists are coming to campus on 8/28/2023 and 8/29/2023. Two final candidates will be recommended to the Board of Supervisors and they will make the final decision. There was interest in reading the feedback received from the campus and CB will find out if this is possible and send it to Connie Phelps and Steve Rick. CB encouraged everyone to attend the meetings with candidates.

Connie Phelps provided an update from the Faculty Senate President. New senators should send their choice for committee assignment—ranked 1-5—to Steve Rick and herself. Returning senators should let them know if they want to switch committee assignments.

The International Education Advisory Committee will be meeting next Friday to discuss draft report that will be sent to University administration and then to the senate.


New Business
