

## 2024–2025 Household Size

Your 2024–2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you (and your parent(s) or spouse, if applicable) reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, the financial aid administrator at your school will compare your FAFSA with the information on this form and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this form, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid administrator at your school. Your school may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

- Other people if they now live with you and you provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2025.

#### ➤ Dependent Student's Household Information (Include)

- You and your parent(s) (including a stepparent) even if you don't live with your parent(s). Include a parent who is on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces apart from the family, but not a parent who has died or is not living in the household due to separation or divorce.
- Your parent(s)' other children that live with your parent(s) (or if they live apart due to college enrollment) and if your parent(s) provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.
- Other people if they now live with your parent(s) and your parent(s) provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2025.
