Committee Reports

Concerns & Opportunities:

 FLSA: "With the recent enactment of staff of a certain salary grade being changed to an hourly rate with having to clock in and out, I'm wondering why the staff council wasn't told about this change. Additionally, I'm curious if the staff council has made any noise about this change at all. It is demeaning for employees with higher degrees to be moved from salaried to hourly without any warning at all. To have no voice to be heard, and to inform people at 4pm on the Monday before the change is just disrespectful, especially when morale is already so low. UNO should be embarrassed. From what I've been told, there are other staff pay changes coming in the spring 2025. Can the Staff Council look into this and maybe inform the staff body as to what is on the horizon?"

Answer: This change is to align the university with new Federal regulations. The spirit of the law is to protect people in certain salary ranges from having to work *over* 40 hours without compensation. The first round of positions affected is for those making under \$43,888, or people in a position where peers are making under this amount. - 2. Service with Jazz: "I feel that Service with Jazz should be discontinued once and for all. It has "fallen behind" yet again. There seems to be little or no interest in nominating. The same groups are repeatedly nominated, and the judging/selection has been very harsh."
 - There was a time where we were behind in December and January. Shannon was on medical leave and then Denise Banks passed away which really affected me.
 - Usually pull the winner at the beginning of the month, then the committee meets, we select a winner, I reach out to supervisor to schedule the party, sometimes supervisors ask to postpone celebration until a certain date which can delay the announcement
 - Criteria we have a form on the website, it's open all the time and can be submitted anytime. It used to be really long, now it's only 2 questions. We do struggle to get nominations every month, sometimes when we don't have a nomination I will look at historical submissions and look for areas that haven't had a winner in a while. We have thought of shortening it further.
 - \circ $\;$ The primary criteria is how the employee went above and beyond
 - \circ $\;$ Sometimes they are really long and detailed, sometimes they're really short. It's important that nominations be detailed
 - \circ We do leave prior nominations in the pool for months where we don't get nominations
