

- <u>Workday</u>: Register for courses (add, swap, drop), pay your tuition bill & fee bill, view grades, transfer credits, and much more. A direct link to Workday can be found <u>here</u>
- <u>Finding classes</u>: Description of course can be found in Workday as well as the <u>University Catalog</u>
- <u>Listings of class schedules</u>: <u>Course Bulletin</u>, available online on the Office of the Registrar. Specific course information found in Workday
- <u>Getting advised</u>: Some degree programs require advising before registering each semester. Other programs may restrict registration in certain courses. If you have questions about which courses to take, contact your <u>Graduate Coordinator</u>.

Paying Tuition & Fees in Workday



In Workday, click on the "Finances" app in your menu, and click on "make a payment".

If the total fee bill payment is not made by 1/12, all students can enroll in the <u>Extended Payment</u> <u>Plan Option (EPPO)</u> in Workday, This plan splits the payments into four equal installments for the Spring.

To avoid a late fee, please note that the first installment payment is due on January 12th plus the \$50 EPPO fee.

Below are some of the features that you can access in Workday:

- Accept/Decline Awards
- Account Activity View your current fee bill and any outstanding charges.
- Payment Plan Sign up for a payment plan.
- Payment Elections This task is to be completed if you will receive a refund from the University.

- Coordinates volunteer note takers/use of notetaking software
- Loans equipment for use by students
- Centralizes adaptive technology use/procurement
- Compliance office (ADA, Section 504 and 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973)

Definition: Sexual Harassment

Conduct on the basis of sex that satisfies one or more of the following:

- (1) Quid Pro Quo: An employee of the University conditioning the provision of an aid, benefit, or service of the University on an individual's participation in unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature, whether verbal or physical;
- (2) Sexual Harassment: Unwelcome conduct determined by a reasonable person to be so severe, pervasive, and objectively offensive that it effectively denies a person equal access to the University's education program or activity; or
- (3) "Sexual assault" as defined in 20 U.S.C.1092(f)(6)(A)(v), "dating violence" as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(10), "domestic violence" as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(8), or "stalking" as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(30). Sexual harassment also includes sexual assault, dating violence, domestic violence, and stalking. For purposes of this Policy, the various forms of prohibited Sexual Harassment are sometimes referred to as "Sexual Misconduct."

Scope of Policy

- Institutions must respond when sexual harassment occurs in the institution's education program or activity, against a person in the United States.
- Education program or activity includes locations, events, or circumstances over which the institution exercised substantial control over both the respondent and the context in which the sexual harassment occurred, and also includes any building owned or controlled by a student organization that is officially recognized by a postsecondary institution (such as a fraternity or sorority house).
- Reports about sexual misconduct that happened off campus or in a study abroad program, or for behavior that falls out of the scope of this definition, will be handled in a separate process.

What to do if a student comes to you:

If you are supervising students/student employees, or you are the instructor of record, you are considered a <u>Mandated</u> Reporter. You must let the person reporting to you know that you will have to report to the Title IX Coordinator.

- <u>Mandated Reporter</u>: An employee of the University who is obligated by policy to share knowledge, notice and/or reports of sex discrimination, sexual misconduct, and/or retaliation on behalf of the University
- A student can discuss confidentially with a **Confidential Resource** (Counseling Services or a Confidential Advisor)
- Ask if they are safe; do they need immediate medical or mental health care?
- Listen
- Provide them with information on resources for assistance, found on Title IX website: https://www.uno.edu/titleix




