About the UNO-Gabon Summer Field School:

The University of New Orleans is conducting The Field School in Tropical Ecology (ECOTROP); an eight-week summer field course in tropical ecology and conservation in Gabon, Central Africa that will focus on examining the effects of past human settlements on forest ecology and biodiversity. This research opportunity is open to U.S. students at both the undergraduate and graduate level and will provide hands on mentorship in a variety of disciplines: archeology, ethnobotany, environmental anthropology, geosciences and wildlife biology. Successful applicants will receive six credits for their participation, and will be required to undertake online seminars and classes prior to traveling to Gabon for the field work portion.
