



Fellowship Program

Shawn Gaines was selected for the Minority Fellowship Program administered by the National Board for Certified Counselors and funded through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration. The program funds fewer than 100 graduate students from around the U.S. each year with a \$10k-15k fellowship, access to mentors, and professional development.

Funding Opportunities

MARINE TECHNOLOGY SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year MTS awards significant scholarship funding to graduate students who are accepted into or enrolled in full-time marine-related programs.

Eligibility: Applicants are required to be active members of MTS, with student memberships available for \$25 per year. Additionally, applicants must be full-time graduate students currently enrolled in or accepted into in a marine studies program at an accredited institution.

NASEM GULF RESEARCH PROGRAM (GRP) SCIENCE POLICY FELLOWSHIP: FEBRUARY 26

Graduate students and postdoctoral students gain first-hand experience at the interface of science and policy as they spend one year with decision-makers at agencies across Alabama, Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi, and Texas.

Eligibility:

- Enrolled in a doctoral program or hold an eligible degree (MA, MS, MPH, etc. See website for details) in an area of research
- U.S. Citizen
- Not employed by U.S. federal government

Awardee benefits:

- Stipends ranging from \$58,000-\$63,000
- Health insurance and relocation stipends
