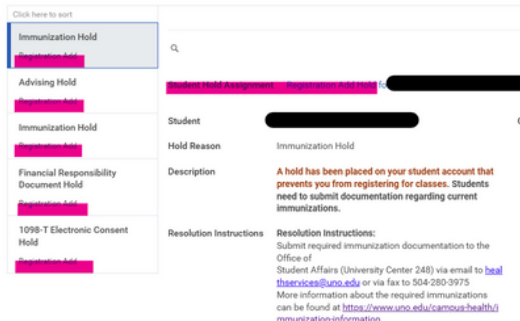

## Registration Tips

Continuing Student Onboarding	Holds	Errors When Adding Classes
All students MUST acknowledge the Financial Responsibility and 1098-T forms prior to registering. Check your home page or click your "My Tasks" icon.	Students can check if they have registration holds by typing "View My Active Holds" in the search bar. Look for hold type "Registration Add Hold" in your list.	Many graduate classes have restrictions on them and require students to request an override. Type "Override" in the search bar to start the process. *Note: Once approved, students must return to Workday to enroll in the course.

## → **THE COMMUNITY SOLUTION EDUCATION SYSTEM 2025 SUMMER INTERN**

Summer interns at The Community Solution will have the opportunity to build valuable skills while gaining exposure to a variety of department functions, our partner colleges, and our unique model of support. Interns will participate in high-impact projects, contribute to real-world solutions, and develop leadership skills that will enhance their future career success. Operational areas vary; see website for details.

Eligibility:

- Currently enrolled in an undergraduate or master's degree program and in good academic standing.
- An interest in nonprofit organizations, higher education, or community-focused work is preferred, but not required.
- Previous internship or work experience in relevant fields (e.g., marketing, finance, human resources, etc.) is a plus, but not mandatory.
- Open to diverse perspectives and committed to fostering inclusive, equitable environments.

Pay is \$20/hour and the internship is conducted virtually.

The Grants Management Intern will gain exposure to various projects including analysis, balance sheet reconciliations and grant maintenance activities. The Grants Management department currently manages 27 grants, which is a mix of federal, state, local government and private foundational grants and contracts.

The partnership between LDWF and UNO allows employees to conduct research in a lab setting for the marine fisheries staff members.
Life Science & Chemistry	<p><u>ZestBIO, Inc</u></p> 	ZestBIO, Inc develops novel bioconversion and enzymatic solutions for industrial processes, working with agricultural companies to develop novel products from processing side-streams. ## **GRADUATE INTERJURISDICTIONAL RESEARCH AWARD FELLOWSHIP (GIRAF): APRIL 18**

A one-year, paid experience for graduate students conducting faculty-mentored research related to sediment loss, coastal habitats and biota, mitigation and adaptation responses, erosion, or other related areas. Award amount \$10,000.

Eligibility:

- US citizen
- Enrolled full-time in graduate program at an accredited Louisiana university
- In good academic standing

## **NATIONAL WILDLIFE FEDERATION FELLOWSHIPS: APRIL 20**

Paid, 4--6-month fellowship research projects in four areas: Wildlife Education, Native Plant Habitat Education, EcoLeader Community and Project Management Office. Award amount \$5,000 stipend.

Eligibility:

- Enrolled in a graduate program through the duration of the grant period
- Valid work authorization
- Any discipline
