Discussion Items

1. Selection of a Vice Chair

Two UCCC members; Dr. Wright and Dr. Green were nominated for the Vice Chair position. After a vote Dr. Green was elected for the 2016-2018 term.

2. Upper repeat limit for courses.

It was decided that all courses that do not specify an upper repeat limit (maximum times a course can be repeated) will have an upper limit of 99, unless specified by the department to increase this.

3. Graduate course's prerequisites not yet programmed.

UCCC will start the process of programming Graduate Courses. A list of all graduate level courses will be distributed soon. Departments can submit multiple course changes via one fast track form, if they are only making prerequisite changes and all courses belong to the same department.

4. Inactivate courses that have not been taught in 3 years.

Rajni will distribute a list of all courses that have not been offered for the last 3 years to the College Deans. The Deans and Department Chairs will make a decision if the course should be inactivated or not. The deadline for this process will be October 15, 2016.

5. Courses with no description.

Rajni will distribute a list of all courses that do not have a course description. The Departments will submit a form for adding course descriptions. The deadline for this process will be October 5, 2016.

6. It was also discussed that there should be a FAQ section on the UCCC website.
